De wijn

De icoonwijn van Toscane - perfect afgerijpt en op dronk. Een unieke fles, slechts 1 exemplaar beschikbaar.

Robert Parker (96/100): "The 2013 Tignanello represents the beginning of a new chapter for Italy's ultimate game-changer wine. The blend remains 80% Sangiovese with 15% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Cabernet Franc but Renzo Cotarella tells me "stylistically-speaking, this is what we wanted to achieve." The winemaking formula remains the same, but one of the major differences and benefits to this wine is vineyard age. The celebrated Tignanello single vineyard is now reaching 15 years old. In other words, it is in its production prime. This is a harmonious and beautifully integrated wine that reveals black fruit and baking spice. I'm told the 2014 Tignanello will have a greater percentage of Cabernet Sauvignon and the 2015 vintage will have more Sangiovese."

James Suckling (97/100): "This is amazing on the nose with blackberry, black truffle, dried cherry and hints of tobacco. So complex on the nose. Almost no need to taste it. Full body, soft and velvety tannins, and a persistent, fabulous finish. The mouthfeel is magic." Decanter (95/100): "Winemaker Renzo Cotarella declared the 2013 to be one of the most vibrant Tignanellos Antinori has ever made. It recalls 2010 but is a slightly less powerful package. The Cabernet Sauvignon is particularly evident at the moment, with well-defined nuances of blackberry bush. Notes of fresh dark earth, red cherry and minerality lurk underneath. The tannins are long and refined but not quite ready to relax their grip. Currently austere rather than generous, this needs time to knit together."

Wine Spectator (95/100): "Defined by licorice and black currant aromas and flavors, this is intense and harmonious. A crisp, vibrant feel pervades as this winds down, showing excellent length and a minerally element."

Het wijnhuis

Tenuta Tignanello is gelegen in het hart van de Chianti Classico regio op ongeveer 30 km ten zuiden van Firenze.

De twee allerbeste wijngaarden, Tignanello en Solaia, liggen op dezelfde heuvelrug en hebben bodems van kalk- en leisteen. De wijnstokken genieten gedurende het groeiseizoen van hoge temperaturen overdag en van frissere temperaturen 's avonds.

Deze twee icoonwijnen worden door de internationale pers beschouwd als de meest invloedrijke wijnen in de geschiedenis van de Italiaanse wijnbouw.
